Meeting called to order by President Sheryll Rider.

### Directors' Reports:

- Mr. Allen reported that he received many positive comments about the Solo/Ensemble contest held at the Highland Middle School. He was also very pleased with the way everything worked out. He also reported that 57 middle school students participated in the solo contest. He commented that he will offer to host this again next year. He reported that approximately 150 or so 5th through 8th grade students went to band contest this year. He also asked for chaperones for upcoming events on April 5, 19 and 26.
- Mr. Davis reported that 22 solos from Grantfork 5th and 6th grades participated in the band contest. They all received a 1st. He reported that the high school concert band is working on the Organizational contest, which is held on April 12.
- Mr. Dugger reported that the high school symphonic band is also working on the material for Organizational contest for April 12. Symphonic band is also attending the ISU Concert Band Festival on April 26.

### Old Business

- High School Musical Concession Stand- Sheryll asked for volunteers to chair the concession stand at the high school musical on April 4, 5, and 6.
